We welcome new and previous vendors to our festival.

There is a \$25.00 non-refundable donation (\$50 for commercial vendor) to the Highland Historical Society for each booth space rented. No refunds will be made if we have to cancel due to weather conditions. This donation is for all 3 days. Advanced paid reservations will secure you the most advantageous booth area. The request for booths is on a “first come, first served” basis. You may register the days of the show. If you need **to cancel** your reservation, you **MUST notify us BEFORE August 1, 2019.**

WHAT WE PROVIDE:

1. 10' x 12' space on the beautiful Latzer Homestead grounds.
2. A variety of attendees for the historical demonstrations, tours, food, etc. (see flyer)
3. **Electricity** is available at **some sites** for an **additional \$10.00 fee.**
4. We do NOT provide tables, tents, chairs or electric cords. Tents to provide you with shade are recommended. Expect Midwest weather!
5. Restrooms
6. Food is available on the grounds by the Harvest Days committee. Crafters and Vendors may **NOT SELL FOOD** items. (With permission, the sale of homemade jellies, jams, relishes and fresh produce IS PERMITTED.)

LIABILITY – All vendors and your helpers must accept full liability for any injury or loss to themselves or their property while attending the show. This does include a natural disaster. Your acceptance of a booth releases the show management from any liability for any injury or loss.

MANNING YOUR BOOTH – Please have someone in your booth during show hours!

SPACES – Please respect the space that you AND your neighbor have been assigned!

ALL VEHICLES – must be moved after unloading to the Vendor’s Parking Area. **NO PARKING IS ALLOWED ALONG OLD TRENTON ROAD FOR ANYONE!**

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are NOT PERMITTED on the Homestead grounds.

SET UP TIMES – The gates will open for vendors at 6:30 am and close at 6 pm. Friday is a set-up and selling day. We host the Highland Community School District fourth graders and their teachers and parents on Friday. The event is also open to the public on Friday.

EVENT HOURS – **FRIDAY** 7:30 am – 3:00 pm **SATURDAY** 7:30 am – 5:00 pm **SUNDAY** 7:30 am – 5:00 pm

CAMPERS – There are a limited number of camping spots. **Reservations must be made AND there is a fee of \$10.00 per day.**

SALES TAX – It is the responsibility of the vendor to collect and submit the appropriate sales tax.

UPON ARRIVAL – Report to the registration building to obtain your packet and booth assignment. You may drive to your booth for the purpose of unloading items; then your vehicle must be moved to the Vendor’s Parking Area.
